

2nd Amendment Preservation Resolution

Whereas this Resolution, which shall be known and may be cited as the “2nd Amendment Preservation Resolution.”

To prevent federal, or local infringement on the right to keep and bear Firearms, Firearms accessories or ammunition ; nullifying all federal, or local acts in violation of the 2nd Amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

The County Commission of Morgan County, Tennessee DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

The Governing body of Morgan County within the great state of Tennessee finds that:

- A. The 2nd Amendment to the Constitution of the United States reads as follows, “A well-regulated militia being necessary to the security of a free state, the right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed.”*
- B. All federal, or local acts, laws, orders, rules or regulations regarding firearms, Firearms accessories or ammunition are a violation of the 2nd Amendment of the Constitution of the United States.*

SECTION 2

PROHIBITIONS ON FEDERAL, OR LOCAL INFRINGEMENT OF THE RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS, FIREARMS ACCESSORIES OR AMMUNITION.

A. The Legislative Body of Morgan County within the great state of Tennessee declares that all federal , or Local acts, laws, orders, rules, regulations – past, present or future – shall be in violation of the 2nd Amendment to the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of Tennessee are not authorized by the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of Tennessee and violate its true meaning and intent as given by the Founders and Ratifies, and are hereby declared to be invalid within Morgan County and all of its boundaries , shall not be recognized by this County or within all of its boundaries within the state of Tennessee, are specifically rejected by Morgan County and within all of its boundaries within the state of Tennessee, and shall

be considered null and void and of no effect in Morgan County within the state of Tennessee.

B. It shall be the duty of the Legislative body of Morgan County and within all of its boundaries within the great State of Tennessee to adopt and enact any and all measures as may be necessary to prevent the enforcement of any federal, or local acts, laws, orders, rules, or regulations in violation of the 2nd Amendment to the Constitution of the United States or any violation of this resolution.

SECTION 3

EFFECTIVE DATE

A. This act takes effect immediately upon approval by the County Legislative Body and signature of the County Executive.
